NYR is the biggest event that we will do as a Student Ministry this year. More time and planning go into this week than into anything else we do throughout the year. The reason for that is simple...We know that lives are changed at weeks like NYR. This week is an awesome way for students to come face to face with who God is and how he can change their lives. We want this trip to go as smoothly as possible, and for as many people to get the experience of going to a week at NYR and giving God an opportunity to change their lives as much as possible.

How Much?

The cost for NYR this year is \$250

The \$250 payment covers the registration cost, food and supplies, transportation costs, a group shirt, water bottle, and Friday and Saturday activities while we are gone. Students will need to bring money for 3 meals on the way out and any travel snacks, cd's, t-shirts or souvenirs.

Each Camper will be allowed one 35 gallon storage tub.

-Clothes (a little of all seasons),

- The temperature can be in the 40s in the morning and 90s in the afternoon and back down in the 40s at night. Also note you are camping on a dirt hill, don't bring your best stuff.
